

## ANNEXURE I

### HAIR REGULATIONS : GIRLS

The basic rule is that hair must be neat and tidy and must not draw undue attention. Hair is not a fashion item; the emphasis is on simplicity, within bounds of what is expected of a learner's appearance.

1. No coloured bands, clips, bows etc. other than navy blue or black.
2. NO headgear.
3. No butterfly clips or clamps.
4. Hair must be tied up if touching the collar.
5. Fringes below the eyebrows must be clipped back.
6. No "mod" hair styles e.g. punk or little curls or pigtails hanging down the back, sides, or on top of head, no perms or dreadlocks.
7. Hair may not be tinted, washed with a colour rinse dyed or highlighted. Any girl who violates this rule will be required to restore her hair to its original natural colour.
8. No big bows or fancy hair ornaments allowed.
9. Braids:
  - Not more than 0,5 cm thick plaits and no lower than shoulder blades when tied up from the neck down (35 cm).
  - Black and dark brown are the only colours allowed.
  - No braids with fringes.
  - No more than one colour of braids.
  - No highlighted braids
  - Must be the same colour as your own hair.
10. Ponytails : Extensions
  - Must be the same colour as the natural hair.
  - If in bun, at back of head, not on top
11. Weave
  - Only black and dark brown coloured weaves.
  - Weave no lower than shoulder blades when tied up from the neck down (35cm).
  - Attachment must not be visible.
12. Corn – rows
  - In a linear pattern only
